Nitmiluk Gorge is 29km from Katherine town centre.

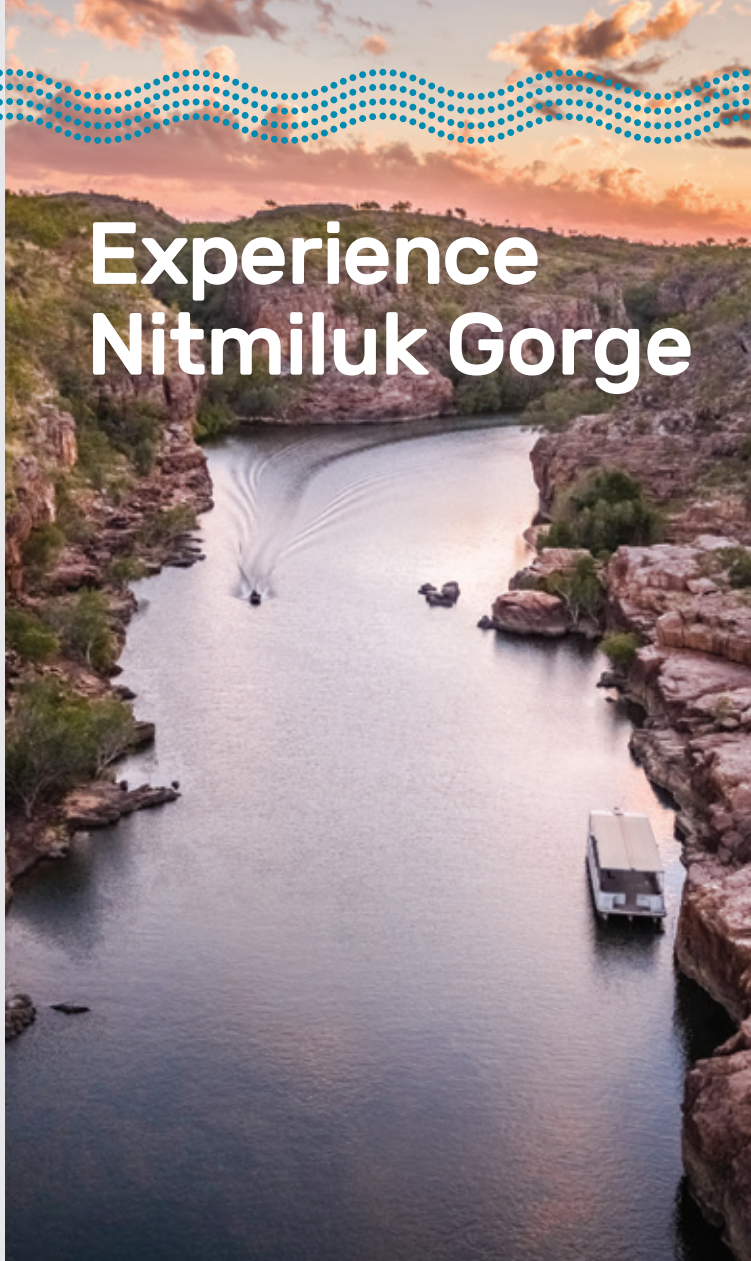
Katherine is approximately 320km from Darwin on the Stuart Highway.

There are regular bus services from Darwin to Katherine.

Chartered fixed wing or helicopter transfer options can be arranged.

Boat Tours

Nitmiluk (Katherine) Gorge is a rugged network of waterways, carved from the Arnhem Land Plateau. By boat is the most popular way to experience the first 2 to 3 Gorges. Learn the geology and history of the area and embrace the Culture of the traditional land owners – the Jawoyn People. Tours are available daily (year round), depending on your schedule and budget, options range from 2 to 4 hours throughout the day.

Please note: A moderate amount of walking is involved. Between each connected gorge, you will disembark and walk to the next (about 1,640 feet or 500 metres), where you can reboard the boat. If you choose not to complete the walk, there is a shaded area for resting.



Cultural Tours

Cutta Cutta Caves Tour is guided tour within the Cutta Cutta Nature Park. Explore tropical limestone caves, and experience native wildlife, Aboriginal Culture, and modern European History amongst the most breathtaking scenery.

Footsteps of our Ancestors is a two-hour cultural presentation sharing insights into Jawoyn Culture. Our Indigenous guides will provide information on traditional activities such as basket weaving, spear throwing, fire lighting, painting, and didgeridoo playing (based on availability).

Canoe Adventure Tours

Experience freedom on a Canoe Adventure! All tours commence with a scenic boat ride along the first gorge, before taking to the waters at the start of the second gorge to explore at your own leisure. This experience can be as challenging or relaxing as you choose, with breathtaking views of the escarpment walls and rocky portages between each gorge.

Ensure you grab a map before you go as there may be some walking trails or swimming holes to explore on your journey!

Minimum age is 6 years old and children under the age of 11 must be accompanied by an adult.

Helicopter Tours

By Helicopter is the only way to view all 13 Gorges, and truly appreciate the size of the National Park.

Our Helicopters have the exclusive landing rights with-in the Park, allowing our guests to exclusively enjoy swimming in a remote rockpool nestled in the escarpment, or visiting Art Galleries not accessible by any other means.

Flights are available daily, year round, offering a range of products to suit all budgets and itineraries.

Optional Upgrades can be added to all flights (excluding the 3 Gorge Flight) to include a remote landing on the escarpment overlooking the Gorge System and/or an extended return flight path over 17 Mile Valley.
